



## Parents' School Improvement Suggestions

Your views are extremely important to us and as a team we are always trying to action any improvements suggested.

Please see below suggested improvements from parents and what we have done to action them.

You said - **Provide more details about what the children are learning in school.**

**We did** - Curriculum maps are sent home every term detailing what each class will be learning about. A copy of the curriculum maps can be found in the notice boards outside each classroom and a copy can also be found on the school's website.

More detailed curriculum coverage can be found on the school's website which includes maths, science and geography coverage for the year. English, history, PE, music, computing, art and design and technology will be following shortly as we plan and implement the new curriculum.

You said - **Children to go on more visits or have more visitors in.**

**We did** - St Ann's Well Academy is part of L.E.A.D Academy Trust and as part of that partnership we have access to a company called Contour. Contour specialises in researching and finding different visits and visitors to help to enrich children's learning. We are still in the early stages of this relationship and as a team we are busy planning and implementing the new national curriculum and researching new engaging activities to support pupils' learning.

You said - **I would like to see more after school clubs.**

**We did** - As a staff we reviewed what after school clubs were being provided and we believe the range and number of clubs available to children is extensive.

In the spring term these are the clubs which are available to the children.

Monday - Kung Fu, cookery, drawing and recorders (lunch time).

Tuesday - Sports, ballet, art and craft and choir (lunch time).

Wednesday - Area band, film club taster and Nottingham Forest Club (lunchtime)
